The Home Place is an independent living facility with a mission to provide affordable housing for the homeless living with HIV/AIDS.

A Place to Call Home

Since 1997, the Home Place has been providing a supportive and compassionate environment for at-risk and/or homeless people with a diagnosis of HIV/AIDS. Located in a convenient part of Chattanooga, the Home Place is close to hospitals and doctors' offices, and is on the bus line.

The Home Place offers seven fully furnished efficiency style apartments, with private baths that feature all the necessary items for comfortable living. Common areas of the home include a kitchen, dining room, living room, deck, yard and cook-out area.

The residents are responsible for keeping their apartments and common areas at The Home Place clean. We have chosen to provide The Home Place with resources to accomplish this task.
