- **2. Develop a plan to be financially secure** through improved financial oversight, a realistic budget and development of a wider scope of donors.

- **3. Develop efficient office operations. Hire an Executive Director who will manage the staff. Make new provisions **for staff training using updated technology.** This will be **key in maintaining** an accurate membership data base to provide information to members and reports to leadership.**
- **4. Provide more leadership training opportunities** for affiliates and members using the LTD program and other NCCW resources. Members must feel value in belonging to NCCW. **There will be broad based programs and a National project that encourages and welcomes participation.** The basic elements of an NCCW program will be:
 - Do-ability,**
 - Flexibility,**
 - Measurability,**
 - Accountability.**
- **5. Make available a user friendly NCCW web site** that provides comprehensive spiritual and educational material to **Catholic Women.**
